A lively group of Harvard Club members, family, and guests attended the New Shakespeare Theater's performance of Our Town on October 26th, a perfect autumn day. For many, driving through downtown Madison on the way to the theater during Halloween weekend, set the stage for the small-town slice of life glimpsed in Thornton Wilder's view of Grover's Corners. This 75th anniversary production of the Pulitzer Prize winning play turned out to be a tremendously appealing choice for our group members, most of whom had read, seen, or even acted in the play during early student days. The talented actors in this performance beautifully expressed the play's themes revolving around coming-of-age experiences, phenomena of everyday life, the meaning of friendship, and reflections on the passage of time.

As the director of the play explained during the fascinating talk-back after the show, in which the cast responded to audience questions about the play, Our **October 26. 2013**

Town touches on aspects of life, both "mundane and magnificent." Thoughtprovoking inquiries by Sharon Dennis Wyeth '70 about the director's personal conception of the themes of the play and by Richard Dixon '58, Ph.D. '64 about the use of a cappella music in the production enlivened the discussion for all.

With thoughts and emotions stimulated by this inspiring production, club members and guests gathered for dinner at Shanghai Jazz for a sumptuous Chinese food banquet. Martha Chang KSG '88 GSAS '93, the owner of the restaurant, welcomed our group warmly and provided an atmosphere of "jazz and joy." This fall Harvard Club event exemplified the pleasures of savoring good company, new and old friendships, and the art of theater.
